
## **How to Apply Conditional Formatting**


## For Rule "Format Only Cells That Contain"

1. Select the area or data that you want to apply conditional formatting to.




2. From the main menu Home tab, select Conditional Formatting -> Manage Rules -> New Rule





- 3. Select the rule "Format only cells that contain"
  - Colors green, yellow and red are used for the values.
  - For this example, green value ranges from 4.5-5.0, yellow value ranges from 4.0-4.49 and red value ranges from 0-3.9.
