ACGME Requirements*

- One goal of ACGME-accredited education is to educate physicians who seek and achieve board certification. One measure of the effectiveness of the educational program is the ultimate pass rate (V.C.3.)*
- The curriculum must be structured to optimize fellow educational experiences, the length of these experiences, and supervisory continuity (IV.C.1.)*
- Fellows must participate in investigations into the various areas of neurocritical care, such as new instrumentation, identification of important physiologic parameters, evaluation of pharmacological agents in critically ill patients, health outcomes, and/or health policy issues related to neurocritical care (IV.C.9.)*
