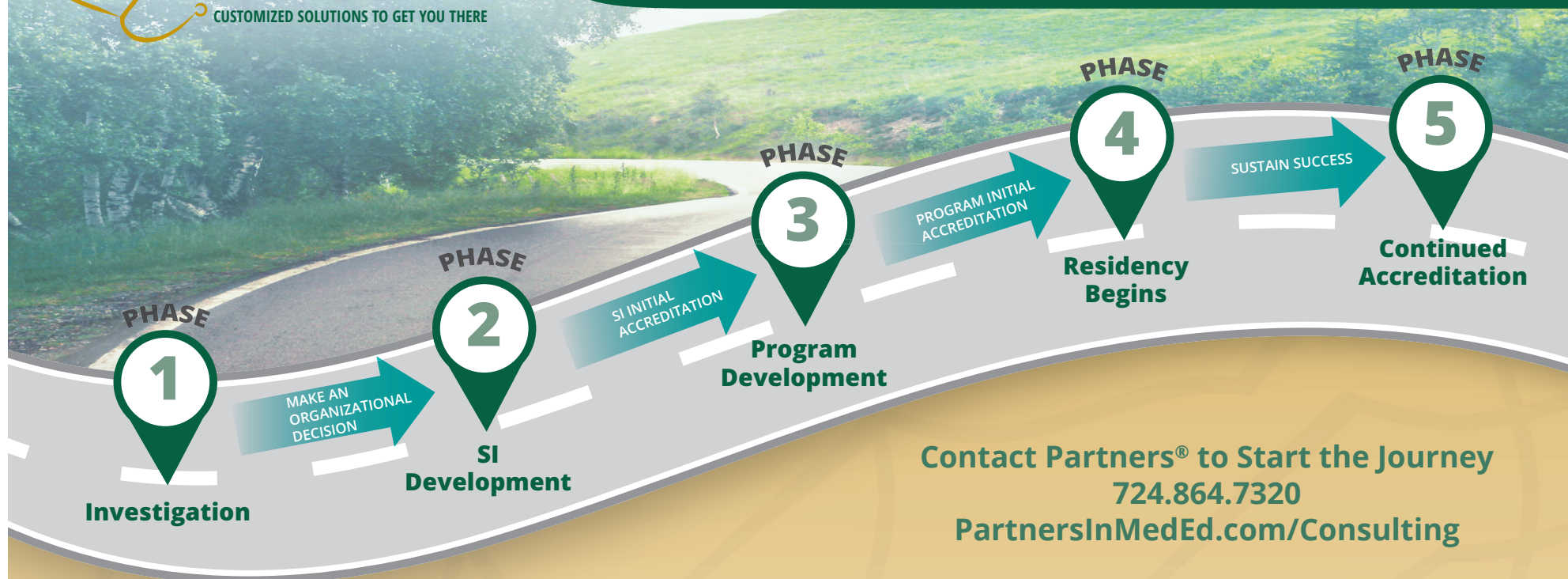


# RURAL TRAINING TRACK ROADMAP

## PHASE 1 Investigation

- What assets are available in the community?
- Who will lead GME?
- What funding options are available?

## PHASE 2 SI Development

- Identify PD
- Develop an accreditation timeline that maximizes resources
- Develop a proforma based on timeline
- Hire DIO and submit SI application
- Develop GMEC and approve institutional policies

## PHASE 3 Program Development

- Hire PD and ensure appropriate FTE
- Programmatic design
- Hire staffing, appoint faculty, PEC & CCC
- PLAs and site development
- Submit application at least 2 months prior to close date
- Residency Programs require a site visit
- Construction of resident sleeping rooms, meeting space and program offices

## PHASE 4 Residency Begins

- Marketing of residency and residency fairs
- NRMP, ERAS, FREIDA
- Conduct faculty development sessions
- Establish annual budgets
- Matriculate and orient residents

- AIR
- SI Self-study report
- GMEC Program oversight
- Program continuous QI
