- Educational agreement between sites
- Required components in CPR
- Must update when things change

07 Policies

- Program specific based on CPR + Specialty
- Annual review recommended
- Accessible to all in program

01 Requirements

- Always use the latest requirements
- Check documents and resource section
- Follow proposed changes

02 Didactics

- Structured, protected
- Track dates, topic/title, presenters
- Includes all educational activities

03 Goals & Objectives

- Competency based
- PGY level specific (progressive)
- Incorporates Milestones 2.0

04 Evaluations

- Faculty, Resident, Peer, Self, Nurse, Patient
- Semi-annual with required elements
- Direct observation; procedure competency

05 Clinical Competency Committee

- Formal resident review, twice per year
- Faculty led; PD has final authority
- Recommends progression of resident to PD
- Assigns Milestone ratings
